RECEIVER'S SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINES FOR VICTIMS AND/OR PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES TO VIEW PHOTOGRAPHS AND SUBMIT CLAIMS FOR PERSONAL PROPERTY ITEMS

Michael I. Goldberg (the "Receiver"), pursuant to Rule 4 of the Complex Business

Litigation Rules, seeks entry of an Order extending the deadline through October 3, 2022 for

victims and/or Personal Representatives to view the photographs of recovered personal property

items on the Receiver's website and submit their claims to the Receiver.

1. On June 8, 2022, this Court entered an Order Granting the Receiver's Motion to Extend

Deadlines for Victims and/or Personal Representatives to View Photographs and Submit Claims

for Personal Property Items. Accordingly, the deadlines initially set forth in the Court's October

10, 2021 Order were extended to August 1, 2022.

2. The Receiver has spoken with many victims' families who have requested additional

time to view the website and make claims, particularly because they been dealing with the class

action settlement and the settlement claims process.

3. It should be noted that Miami-Dade County has continued to find, decontaminate and

photograph additional personal property, and the Receiver will be including photographs of those

items on the website as part of a second claims process in the months ahead. The County also

intends to conduct a final search of the rubble, using heavy equipment, and such search may yield

additional personal property items. Those items will also be part of the second claim process.

Moreover, the County has undertaken, at its own expense, to decontaminate soft religious items (where possible), and the Receiver anticipates including those soft religious items as part of the

second claims process.

4. Accordingly, with respect to items included on the Receiver's website to date, the

Receiver requests that the protocol approved in the October 10, 2021, and previously extended to

August 1, 2022, be extended to October 3, 2022 so that victims and/or Personal Representatives

have sufficient time to view the photographs and submit their claims to the Receiver.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver respectfully requests that the Court grant this Motion and

extend the above-referenced deadlines set forth in the initial October 10, 2021 Order to October 3,

2022.
