RECEIVER'S UNOPPOSED MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON RECEIVER'S MOTION TO CONFIRM COMPLIANCE WITH ARTICLE 6.7 OF THE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT IN CONTEMPLATION OF DISTRIBUTION

In support of this motion, the Receiver states as follows:

- 1. The *Receiver's Motion to Confirm Compliance* was filed on November 18, 2022. The Court re-noticed the hearing on the motion for January 3, 2023, at 2:00 p.m.
- 2. Class Plaintiffs, the Terra Defendants, and DeSimone are the only parties to file responses to the motion. Their counsel have been involved in discussions of the issues raised and

believe that the issues raised by the Receiver's Motion to Confirm Compliance may be resolved

amicably such that a hearing is unnecessary.

3. In addition, Plaintiffs' Lead Co-Counsel are out of town and the Receiver has a

long-planned out-of-country vacation commencing at the end of this week, both of which make

discussions of the issues more complicated than ideal.

4. Accordingly, the Receiver requests – on an unopposed basis – that the hearing on

the Receiver's Motion to Confirm Compliance be rescheduled such that counsel may complete

their discussions.

5. A proposed order is attached as Exhibit A and will be uploaded to CourtMap

concurrently with the filing of this motion.
