This past Friday, the Court held a status conference and held a brief discussion on my *Motion for Authorization to Donate Potential Money Left Over After Payment of All Awards, Taxes, and Administrative Expenses to Fund a Memorial for the Victims* ("Motion"). As discussed in the Motion, it is possible that the receivership estate may have excess funds after payment of all awards and expenses which could be used to help fund a memorial honoring the victims who tragically perished in the collapse. While it is impossible to predict the exact amount of excess funds that will be available, I do believe it could be in the approximate range of \$2,000,000 to \$3,000,000 dollars.
